




The Warren County Sports park consists of moving over 300,000 cubic yards of dirt to create 2 playgrounds, 12 natural grass soccer fields, and 2 synthetic turf championship soccer fields. There are also 2 synthetic turf championship baseball and softball infields along with 4 natural grass baseball fields. All natural grass athletic fields are fully irrigated, pulling water from neighboring Armco park. Additionally, there are 2 concession stands constructed with masonry ad metal roofs. Both stands include restrooms with over 3,000 lineal feet of sanitary force main.





330,000 SF of addition and complete renovation, the first since 1966, encompasses the Middletown High School. This includes a new arena, new science wing, new addition for music as well as a new community center, classroom spaces and offices.

The site work was inclusive of a retention pond, the demo of another school on the property, **a new track and field with stadium**, expanded parking, drive and the doubling of bus routes.


